2016 Broadway Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA edged Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA 258 – 257 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Broadway Lanes on Saturday, October 29th.

The stepladder finals began with third-seeded Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA defeating fourth-seeded Kenny Livengood of Ravena 258 - 211. Livengood won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. The second-seeded Kempton then defeated Hall 200 - 192 to set up the title match. Hall earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

In the title match, Kempton began with a spare followed by five consecutive strikes to open up a 31-pin lead. Hankey responded by throwing seven consecutive strikes from the fifth frame through the tenth frame to close the gap; take a 9 pin lead; and force his opponent to strike on his first ball in the tenth frame. Kempton was up to the challenge, as he closed with a strike followed by a spare to earn his fourth CDYST title and a \$250 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys division. Hankey won a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on a 37-foot custom-designed USBC sport-compliant lane condition, Livengood, Hankey, and Hall were the respective leaders following each of the first three games. Hankey regained the lead after Game 4; followed by Livengood once again after Game 5. Those two competitors would complete the round tied for the lead heading into the semifinals. In the semifinals, Hankey won his first match to become the sole leader. He followed with two more victories to earn the top seed for the finals. Kempton won two of his three matches rise from fifth and become the second seed. Hall was undefeated to vault from seventh place into third. Livengood earned a close victory in his last semifinal match to round out the top four.

A total of 37 bowlers (27 boys and 10 girls) competed in the third tournament of the season. Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are Alex Alesio of Schenectady (\$50) in fifth place and Andrew Bourgeois of Blossvale (\$40) in sixth. In the Girls Division, Jessica Shufelt of Watervliet finished first (12th overall) and won a \$125 scholarship; Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$75) finished second (13th overall); and Natalya Porcello of Albany (\$40) finished third. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,020 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$3,435.

Byrnes, Shufelt, Livengood, Bourgeois, Alesio, Zack Terry of Schenectady, and Morgan Brunet of Plattsburgh earned entries into the 2017 USBC Junior Gold Championships in Cleveland.

Our next tournament is the first-ever CDYST Doubles Classic beginning at 1:30 pm on Saturday, November 19th at Sportsmans Bowl in Rotterdam. The event is open to teams of any two USBC-certified youth bowlers; with a limit of one CDYST singles champion per team. 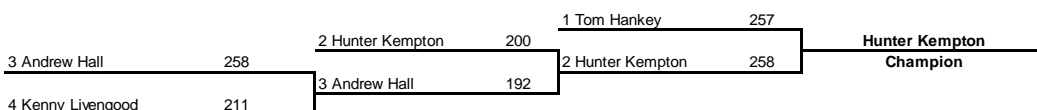
