Huck Finn's Capital Region Bowling / CDYST Challenge Rules

USBC Certification Number: 05132

Tournament Directors: Mark Taylor and Steve Fawcett

- 1) The Huck Finn's Capital Region Bowling / CDYST Challenge is a scratch singles tournament with one division.
- 2) The event will begin at 12:30 pm on Sunday January 22, 2017. However, we ask that bowlers arrive at least 45 minutes early to check in and receive their lane assignments.
- 3) **The tournament is limited to CDYST members only.** Non-member bowlers who have competed in at least one event during the 2016 – 2017 season may pay their membership fee at the tournament site and participate in this event.
- 4) The entry fee is \$30 with the following breakdown: \$12 lineage; \$18 scholarship fund.
- 5) The tournament format will be as follows: All bowlers will roll four games in the qualifying round; switching pairs after each game. At the completion of the qualifying round, the top two bowlers will advance to the televised stepladder finals as the top two respective seeds. The bowlers ranked 3rd through 6th will roll a single game elimination match; with the top two scorers advancing as the third and fourth seeds into the stepladder finals. The advancing bowler with the higher five-game series will earn the third seed. The fifth and sixth place finishers will be determined based on their respective five-game total pinfall. **If there is a time constraint based on the taping schedule, the Elimination Round will be removed and the top four bowlers will advance to the stepladder finals.**
- 6) In the finals, the 4th place qualifier will bowl against the 3rd place qualifier in a one-game match; the winner will bowl against the 2nd qualifier; that winner will face the tournament leader to determine the champion. The higher-seeded bowler will have the choice of starting lane in each match.
- 7) Tardy bowlers must begin with the frame being bowled. No pins will be credited for frames missed.
- 8) If a player bowls on the wrong lane or out of turn and does not roll a strike, they will shoot the spare and that is their frame. If they roll a strike, the ball will not count and they will bowl in the correct order on the correct lane.
- 9) No ball surface adjustments may be made after the start of competition is announced. If a bowler is found to have made a ball surface adjustment after competition begins, they will receive 0 pinfall for any frames the ball was used; and the ball will be removed from competition.
- 10) A minimum of 1 in 5 entrants will earn a scholarship. The champion will also receive a trophy. All scholarship winners will receive a certificate indicating their position and prize.
- 11) The lanes will be dressed with a customized Challenge-level pattern designed by Kegel.
- 12) **All bowlers must wear a collared or mock-collar shirt and slacks** to comply with the dress code for television. Please refer to the CDYST Code of Conduct, which addresses acceptable attire and behavior. It is available online, at the tournament site, or via e-mail.
- 13) All scholarship money will be held by and distributed in accordance with the USBC SMART Program.
- 14) All rules not specifically addressed herein will be subject to the USBC Rulebook. For matters not directly addressed in the USBC Rulebook, the tournament directors' decision is final.
- 15) The Huck Finn's Capital Region Bowling / CDYST Challenge will count towards eligibility into the 2017 CDYST Masters. Bowler of the Year performance points will be awarded as follows: 40 pts for 1st place; 30 pts for 2nd; 20 pts for 3rd; 15 pts for 4th; 10 pts for 5th; 8 pts for 6th; 7 pts for 7th; and 6 pts for 8th. If there are at least 50 entries, the champion will receive 50 pts with points awarded on a declining scale down to the 10th place bowler receiving 6 pts. All other bowlers who finish within the top 1 in 3 will receive 5 points.
- 16) For an optional \$5 fee, bowlers may enter the scholarship eliminator prior to the start of competition. A minimum of 1 in 8 entrants will receive a scholarship prize. All eliminator monies will be returned 100%.
