



2017 Hometown Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA defeated Lauren Piotrowski of Schenectady 214 - 188 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Hometown Lanes on Saturday, March 18th.

The stepladder finals began with third-seeded Christopher Radliff of Schenectady defeating fourth-seeded Zack Terry of Schenectady 238 - 214. The fourth place finisher Terry earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division. The second-seeded Piotrowski then defeated Radliff 243 - 183 to set up the title match. The third place finisher Radliff won a \$150 scholarship for finishing second in the Boys Division.

In the title match, Piotrowski began with three strikes in the first four frames to take a 16-pin lead. Kempton responded with four consecutive strikes in the fifth through eighth frames to erase the deficit and take a 16-pin lead of his own. Another strike in the tenth frame clinched his fourth title of the season (seventh career). He earned a \$250 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. The runner-up Piotrowski earned a \$200 scholarship as the top finisher in the Girls Division.

Competing on the 47-foot Kegel Statue of Liberty Landmark Challenge Series pattern, Kempton began with a 269, the highest game of the day, to lead after Game 1. Jenna Lemke of Delmar moved ahead following Game 2; before Kempton returned to the lead after Game 3 and would remain there with a 966 four-game series, the highest of the season, heading into the semifinals. In the semifinals, Lemke jumped ahead once again after winning her first match. However, Kempton closed with two consecutive victories to earn the top seed for the finals. Piotrowski rolled a 724 series and won all three of her matches to vault from 14th place after qualifying into second. Radliff also won his three matches to rise from seventh to third; while Terry rolled a 704 series and was undefeated to jump from 16th place and earn the final berth for the finals.

A season high of 53 bowlers (33 boys and 20 girls) competed in the twelfth tournament of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Girls Division are Melanie Lemke of Delmar (\$125) in second place (fifth overall); Jenna Lemke of Delmar (\$75) in third (sixth overall); and Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady in fourth (13th overall). The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division are Christian Chiarito of Schenectady (\$75) in fourth place (seventh overall); Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA (\$50) in fifth (eighth overall); Dominick Favata of Niskayuna (\$40) in sixth (ninth overall); and Willis Bickford of Fort Edward (\$35) in seventh (tenth overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,310 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$16,300.

Our final open tournament of the 2016 - 2017 season will begin at 1:00 pm on Saturday April 8th at East Greenbush Bowling Center. It is open to any USBC youth-certified bowler and will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for any CDYST member who has competed in at least three prior events this season.

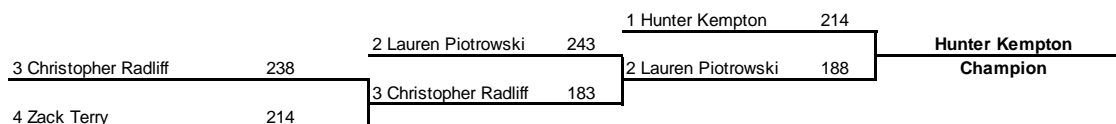
