

2014 CDYST Masters Wrap-up

Chad Sutliff of Valatie won five consecutive matches, including a 210 – 194 victory over Jonathan Bowman of Peru to win the CDYST Masters tournament held on Saturday, May 10th at Town 'n Country Lanes.

Following a six-game qualifying round, the top 16 bowlers competed in single-game matches within a double-elimination format. In Round 4, Sutliff defeated Zachery Porter of Schenectady 210 – 158 to earn a berth into the Championship Round as the sole remaining undefeated bowler. In Round 5, Porter defeated Christopher Radliff of Schenectady 157 – 136; and Bowman defeated Jay Hadcock of Johnstown 203 – 151. Radliff and Hadcock earned \$250 scholarships for finishing fourth and fifth, respectively. Bowman then defeated Porter 237 – 201 to set up the Championship Round. Porter earned a \$400 scholarship for his third place finish.

Being undefeated, Sutliff had to win one match in the Championship Round to earn the title; Bowman had to win two. Bowman began with a spare, followed by three strikes to open up a 22-pin lead. Sutliff responded with four consecutive strikes from frames three through six to close to within three pins. Following a spare by Bowman in the ninth frame, Sutliff, who finished the match first, rolled two strikes in the tenth frame to clinch his second CDYST title and a \$1,000 scholarship. Bowman won a \$600 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Lawrence Lang of Rhinebeck earned a \$100 scholarship for leading the qualifying round with a 1324 series. Patrick DeVoe of Delmar won a \$50 scholarship for being the second highest qualifier. AJ Indovina of Albany earned an entry into the 2014 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held in Buffalo.

The invitational CDYST Masters was the final event of our fourth season and 50th tournament overall. 39 bowlers competed for a record scholarship fund of \$4,350; the top 23 earned prizes of at least \$40. Throughout the season, our talented youth bowlers earned a record \$19,520 in scholarships. We have now surpassed \$50,000 in scholarship awards since our first event in May 2010.

Bowman's second place finish capped off the most dominant season in CDYST history to earn the 2013 – 2014 Bowler of the Year by 140 points over runner-up Ricky Rovelli and 155 points over Sutliff. It also marked the first year the award was clinched prior to the CDYST Masters. In twelve tournaments this season, Bowman won three titles and finished second three other times.

The top eight bowlers in the final Bowler of the Year standings will represent the CDYST in the 2014 USBC Youth Open Championships, being held in Buffalo in July. The bowlers will form two four-bowler teams, as well as four doubles teams, prior to competing in singles and all-events competitions.

The 2013 – 2014 CDYST season is officially complete; the fifth season will begin in early fall. 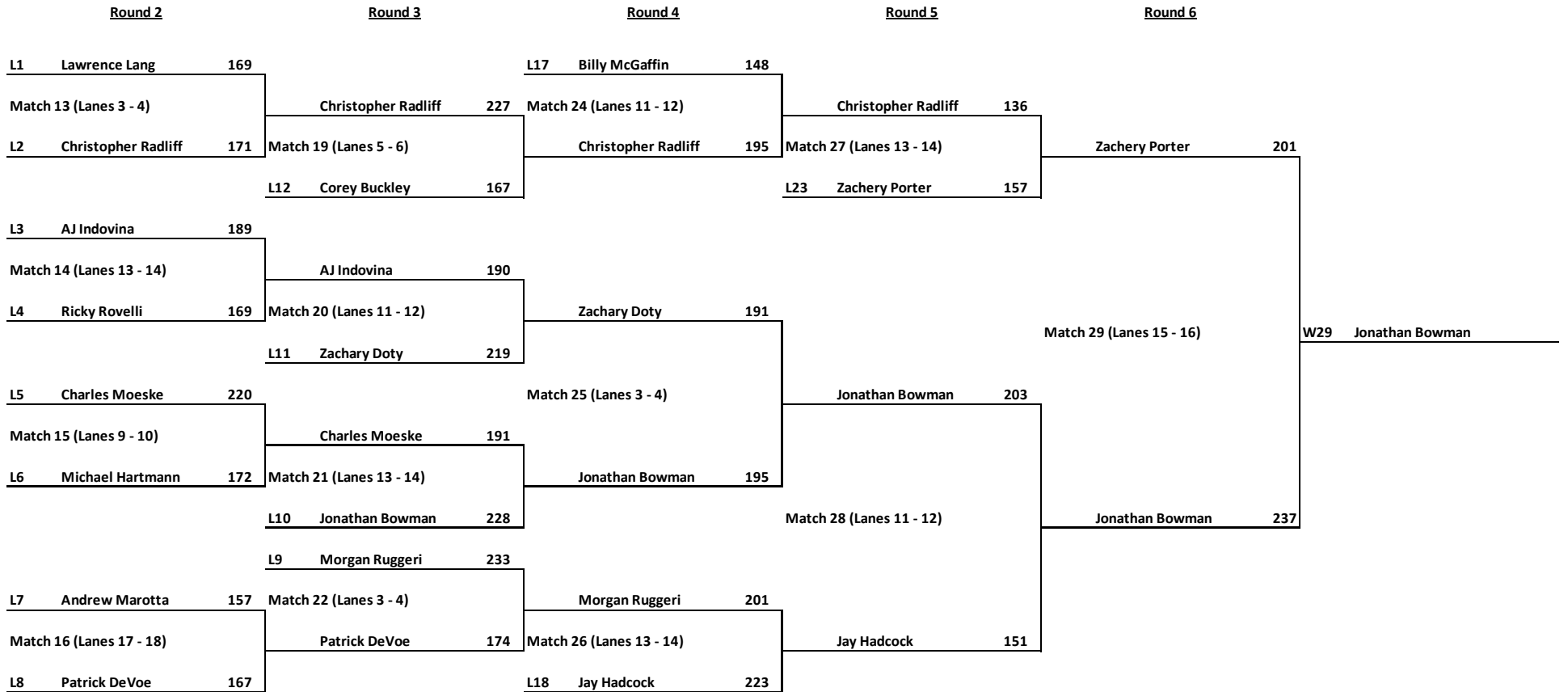
