## CDYST Tournament Rules

USBC Certification Number: 05213

Tournament Directors: Mark Taylor and Steve Fawcett

- 1) All tournaments are scratch singles with one division and open to any USBC youth-certified bowler. However, boys and girls will compete for separate scholarship funds. Uncertified bowlers meeting USBC youth requirements must purchase a USBC youth membership on site.
- 2) The CDYST membership fee is \$30 to cover season-long expenses and awards. Remaining money will be awarded as scholarships at the 2016 CDYST Invitational and Masters.
- 3) Tournament entry fees for CDYST members are \$32 if paid in advance or \$35 if paid on site. All non-members will pay \$45. The breakdown is as follows: \$12 lineage; \$18 scholarship fund; remaining funds to expenses. **For Junior Gold qualifier events, add \$5 to these regular rates.** Entry into Junior Gold qualifiers is optional for CDYST members only and will cost an additional \$40. If a bowler is not USBC Junior Gold-certified and they wish to enter the qualifier, they must certify on site; the cost is an additional \$30. Scores from the Qualifying Round will be used and the number of Junior Gold entries awarded will be contingent upon the number of entries. 1 in 5 bowlers who enter will earn their entry into the Junior Gold tournament.
- 4) All tournaments will begin promptly on the date and time listed. **Please arrive at least 45 minutes early.**
- 5) Tardy bowlers must begin with the frame being bowled. No pins will be credited for frames missed.
- 6) The qualifying round will consist of 4 games (6 games for Junior Gold Qualifiers), switching pairs after each game. The lesser of 1 in 3 bowlers or the number of available lanes will advance to the semifinals. All scores will carryover.
- 7) The semifinals will begin immediately after the qualifying round and consist of 3 head-to-head match games. The bowler winning each match will receive a 30-pin bonus; a tie will award 15 bonus pins to each bowler. The top four bowlers after 7 games (9 games for Junior Gold Qualifiers) will advance to the finals.
- 8) The finals will be a stepladder format; the 4<sup>th</sup> place qualifier will bowl against the 3<sup>rd</sup> place qualifier; the winner will bowl the 2<sup>nd</sup> qualifier; that winner will face the tournament leader to determine the champion.
- 9) **Please note that at host centers with space or time constraints, the tournament directors reserve the right to modify the tournament format to accommodate as many bowlers as possible.**
- 10) The Kegel Challenge or World Tenpin Bowling Association lane condition listed will be employed for that tournament. Please visit our website for links showing the details of each pattern.
- 11) **All bowlers must wear a collared or mock-collar shirt.** Please refer to the CDYST Code of Conduct, which addresses acceptable attire and behavior. It is available at the tournament site, online, or via e-mail.
- 12) A minimum of 1 in 5 entrants will earn a scholarship. The champion will also receive a plaque. All award winners will receive a certificate indicating their position and prize. Scholarship winners in each gender division will be determined by their overall finishing position in the tournament.
- 13) All scholarship money will be held by and distributed according to the USBC SMART Program.
- 14) All rules not specifically addressed herein will be subject to the USBC Rulebook. For matters not directly addressed in the USBC Rulebook, the tournament directors' decision is final.
- 15) For an optional \$5 fee, CDYST members may enter the scholarship eliminator prior to the qualifying round. A minimum of 1 in 8 entrants will receive a scholarship prize. All eliminator monies will be returned 100%.
