## 2013 Del Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Justin Carl of Albany won three matches in the stepladder finals, including a 240 - 236 victory over tournament leader Zachary Doty of Nassau to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Del Lanes on Saturday, December 14th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Carl defeating fourth-seeded Natasha Bidwell of Schenectady 203 - 184. Due to NCAA regulations, Bidwell could not claim her scholarship prize for finishing fourth. Carl then defeated the second-seeded Michael Hartmann of Earlton 259 - 234 to set up the title match. Hartmann earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In the title match, Doty jumped out to a 17-pin lead through four frames. After both competitors rolled strikes in the fourth through eight frames, Carl continued his string with two more strikes in the ninth and tenth frames to take the lead and earn his third CDYST title and a \$275 scholarship. Doty won a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In the qualifying round, Hartmann held the lead after each of the first two games. However, Doty rolled 718 over his final three games to reach the top spot heading into the semifinals. Both bowlers won all three of their semifinal matches to earn the top two seeds heading into the finals. In his second semifinal match, Carl rolled a 300 game, becoming the first bowler to roll multiple perfect games in CDYST competition. His 762 three-game series vaulted him from eighth place into third place.

There were 39 entries in the fifth tournament of the 2013 - 2014 season. Jonathan Bowman earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing fifth; AJ Indovina of Albany won a \$55 scholarship for finishing sixth; Corey Buckley of Albany won a \$45 scholarship for finishing seventh; Austin Van Buren of Altamont won a \$35 scholarship for finishing eighth; and Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa won a \$30 scholarship for finishing ninth. A total of \$915 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$4,920.

The next tournament is the 2013 CDYST Holiday Open, which will be held at Towne Bowling Academy on Sunday and Monday December 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> from 9 am - 3 pm each day. Bowlers may start bowling at any time during the tournament hours and compete as often as they wish. \$500 will be added to the scholarship fund. Our next regular season tournament will be at 1:00 pm on Saturday January 4, 2014 at Alpha Lanes in Troy.
